From the winery: “This Spätburgunder numbers among the finest of the Premium wines from our steep sites. Very carefully hand-selected grapes from mature vines are fermented traditionally, on the skins. This wine matured in small barrique casks (225 liters) for more than a year. Today, the wine is matured with well-integrated tannins.

A truly noble Spätburgunder wine, marked by powerful oak, aromas of wild red fruit, a hint of vanilla and delicate winter spices.”

Situated in Germany’s premier region for Pinot Noir production, the Ahr Valley, Wunder truly represents classic winemaking. Their limited-number production and hand-crafted wines not only indicate the authenticity and uniqueness of their vineyards - many of which are Grand Cru - but also their desire to produce elegant, storied examples of Spätburgunder. Indeed, their wines are produced to live up to their name - “Wünder” being the German word for “miracle”.
